

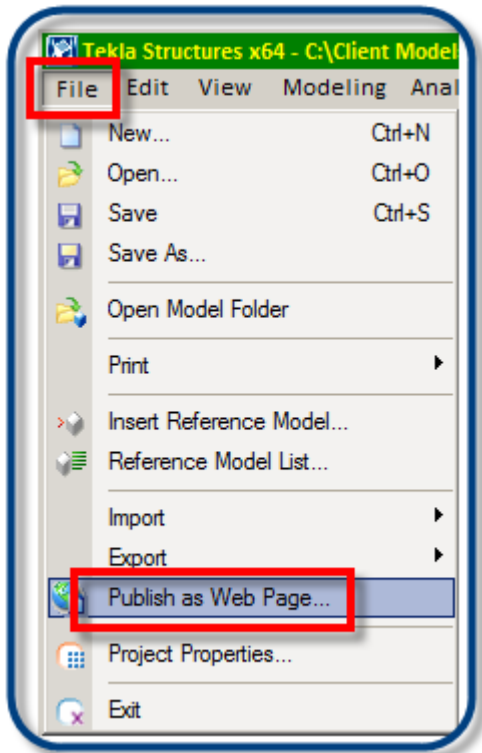
FAQ – How do I allow my customer to view my model?

The easiest method is to supply the customer with either an XML or a ZSOL copy of your model.

The XML file will allow you to add ‘tooltip’ which provide information about the object over which the mouse cursor is currently located, but it cannot display bolts.


The ZSOL version will show bolts, but does not allow the use of ‘tooltips’.

To create either version, use the ‘File’ > ‘Publish as Web Page’ option.



Choose the required options from the ‘Publish as Web Page’ dialog.

In that dialog, choose the correct options for the type of model you wish to send. We suggest that you 'uncheck' the option to 'Open in browser' as we have had many calls about Internet Explorer baulking at ActiveX controls and user permissions.
